Born and raised in Northeast Portland, Eli Levine has been a full-time independent grant writing expert and consultant for more than 10 years, serving over 30 nonprofits across the state of Oregon. Today Eli is considered one of the Pacific Northwest's most successful fundraising professionals, in no small part due to the decades of training and time spent cultivating foundation relationships with retired grant writing expert and father, Rick Levine.
